ASD Aware Scheme

It is estimated that I in 100 people have an Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

People with an ASD use all kinds of services and businesses in Wales.

We are aiming to raise awareness of ASD across all Wales, this will make accessing and using services a lot easier for people with ASD.

The ASD Aware scheme is funded by the Welsh Government as part of the ASD Strategic Action Plan for Wales, and is hosted by the Welsh Local Government Association (WLGA).

Individuals can take part in the ASD Aware scheme by undertaking some learning and answering a series of questions at www.ASDinfoWales.co.uk/ASDaware

If all questions are correctly answered, a personalised certificate will be issued.





Becoming an ASD Aware Organisation

If a significant amount of staff in your area of work take part in the ASD aware scheme you may be eligible to become an ASD Aware organsiation.

This could apply to your whole service or business or a department within your organisation.

Registering as an ASD Aware business will support people with ASD to access your services and will enable them to search for ASD Aware businesses in Wales.

Your organisation will also receive the following benefits:

- Your organisation or department will be issued a certificate stating your business is ASD Aware
- Your organisation or department will be listed on www.ASDinfoWales.co.uk as being an ASD Aware service.
- You will receive permission to use the ASD Aware logo on your documentation.

Registering as an ASD Aware organisation is easy.

- Ensure a significant proportion of your staff have completed the ASD
 Aware certification scheme at www.ASDinfoWales.co.uk/ASDaware
- Ensure your staff enter the same details under the company / service section when registering for the scheme.
- Complete the application form which can be downloaded from www.ASDinfoWales.co.uk/organisations
