The NWIAS covers the counties of Wrexham, Flintshire, Denbighshire, Conwy, Gwynedd and Ynys Mon.



What the NWIAS can offer?

- Autism diagnostic assessment for individuals 18+.
- Support to understand an Autism Diagnosis.
- Access to group work, workshops and individual support.
- Access to other services and resources that we can direct you to for additional support.
- Advice and support for Parents/Carers of Autistic individuals.
- Multi-disciplinary consultation and advice to Statutory Services and Agencies across North Wales.
- Training and promoting Autism awareness across North Wales.
- We can offer consultation to clinicians to assist with effective communication and engaging with Autistic persons.
- Guidance and goal setting to assist with skill building.



What the NWIAS is unable to offer?

- We do not undertake direct assessment or interventions with people under 18 years of age.
- We do not provide crisis response or under take risk assessment nor advise on respite care provision.
- We do not undertake Social Work
- Assessments, care planning and nor do we provide direct payments.
- We do not provide or advise on medication and prescriptions.
- We do not support persons with moderate to severe mental health needs.
- We do not directly support persons with a moderate to severe Learning Disability.
