

Neurodivergence Improvement Programme What are the issues the programme is aiming to address?

- Significant challenges in the referral pathway for children's neurodevelopmental services.
- Sparse services for individuals with Tourettes Syndrome.
- Sparse services for adults with ADHD, based on a medical model with long waits.
- Lack of provision from all adult and children's neurodevelopmental services in relation to accessing advice, information and support whilst on the waiting list, or whilst trying to access a potential referral onto the diagnostic pathway
- Lack of post diagnostic support for families and children diagnosed with a neurodivergent condition.
- Lack of services for those who do not meet diagnostic thresholds
- Challenging wait times
